### **Code of Conduct**



#### **RULES**

- 1. Participants must present their college ID to gain entry to the **hackCBS 8.0** hackathon.
- 2. This event is open to registered members only. Participants must register their team ahead of time; otherwise, entry will not be granted.
- 3. Prizes will be distributed accordingly.
- 4. All members of a participating team must be present at all times; failure to comply may result in disqualification.
- 5. The event is scheduled for 24 non-consecutive hours. Participants may work on their hacks at any time during the declared hacking period, including off-venue hours.
- 6. Final product submissions will be judged after the completion of the hack. Winners will be announced on Sunday, November 9th at Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies, Rohini-16, New Delhi.

# **Regulations For Event**

### 1. Purpose

The **hackCBS 8.0** hackathon will promote a 24 hours (non-consecutive) technological challenge with the main goal of creating a solution to address a challenge in the IT industry.

#### 2. Organization

The **hackCBS 8.0** hackathon is organized by students of SSCBS. These terms and the event will be promoted through the official website of the event at <a href="https://www.hackcbs.tech">www.hackcbs.tech</a>

#### 3. Facilities and Infrastructure

- The hackCBS 8.0 hackathon will be held at SSCBS in New Delhi.
- 3.2. SSCBS reserves the right to change the location and date of the event provided for in the preceding paragraph due to logistical reasons and

- at its sole discretion.
- 3.3. Participants consent that the *hackCBS 8.0* hackathon facilities and infrastructure are for the exclusive use of this event.
- 3.4. Participants will be responsible for their own IT equipment, including laptops, mobile devices, and other electronic devices as needed. Participants are advised to bring their own internet connection, as only one Wi-Fi connection per team will be provided by the organizers.

### 4. Participants and Applications

- 4.1. Any college-going students are eligible to participate in *the hackCBS* **8.0** hackathon.
- 4.2. Individuals can participate in the hackCBS 8.0 hackathon as a team or as an individual. Participants shall be responsible for the organization of the teams and each team shall consist of a maximum of 4 members. Only one application per team will be accepted by the organizers.
- 4.3. The formal application shall be submitted at *the official hackCBS 8.0* hackathon website: www.hackCBS.tech
- 4.4. Applications must include the complete identification of each team member, including full name, contact number, and email. The organizers ensure the confidentiality and protection of all personal data provided for participation in the hackCBS 8.0 hackathon. Data will not be transferred or used for any other purpose.

#### 5. Event Details

- 5.1. The **hackCBS 8.0** hackathon will run for 24 hours (non-consecutive) and is expected to start at 9:00 a.m. on 8th November 2025.
- 5.2. Teams will have these 24 hours (non-consecutive) to create their hack. During this period, teams will present their ideas to select finalists for the judges. The goal of this stage is to select the finalist ideas that will be presented to the judge or panel of judges.
- 5.3. After idea presentations, the judges will deliberate to select the winners.
- 5.4. The event will conclude with the announcement of the winning teams.

#### 6. Panel of Judges

- 6.1. All decisions will be made at the panel's sole discretion. No team or participant may make any claim or appeal against these decisions, whether interlocutory or final.
- 6.2. The decision of the organizers regarding results is final and binding.

## 7. Acceptance of Agreement to the Terms and Conditions

- 7.1. The application to the **hackCBS 8.0** hackathon implies the full acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 7.2. Participants agree to the following conditions for the application and participation in *the hackCBS 8.0 hackathon*:
  - 7.2.1. The solutions developed shall not feature any references of a sexual nature, explicit or suggestive, shall not be offensive, obscene, pornographic or violent or derogatory to any ethnic, racial, religious, professional or age group. They should not encourage any form of hate or group hate nor contain derogatory comments about SSCBS or its products or services, or other people, products or companies.
  - 7.2.2. The solutions developed shall not advertise illegal drugs or firearms (or the use of either), or any activity that may convey unsafe, dangerous or political messages.
  - 7.2.3. The solutions developed shall not present registered trademarks or logos owned by third parties or advertise or promote any brand or product of any kind.
  - 7.2.4. The solutions developed shall not contain materials protected by copyright or property of third parties (including photographs, sculptures, paintings and other works of art or images published on websites or on television, movies or other media). Participants shall ensure that the ideas/prototypes/apps proposed are innovative and original.
  - 7.2.5. The solutions developed shall not present any names, images, photographs or other evidence that identify any person, living or dead, without explicit authorization from them or their representatives.
  - 7.2.6. During the **hackCBS 8.0** hackathon, participants shall act with the utmost courtesy and respect for all persons and entities involved in the event.
- 7.3. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions provided for in this clause may result in, by the decision of the panel of judges, at its sole

discretion, the exclusion of the participant and/or team from *the* **hackCBS 8.0** hackathon with no claim or appeal & they will be liable for the damages incurred and compensate any losses.
